Highways and Footpaths

We have made a number of reports on Fix My Street for pot holes, drain and gully cleaning. Timing issues with the traffic lights by the Toll House are being looked into by WSP.

There are ongoing concerns and much correspondence about the temporary closure of the paths near the Old Forge. These have been set by Shropshire Council's Access Team to enable to landowner to safely make all the necessary repairs.

The Access Team are looking to install a new footbridge from the Glen Caravan Park to the Workhouse Field later this year.

Severn Trent

A meeting is to be arranged to discuss water quality and environmental issues.

We have also requested a public information presentation regarding the recently approved new sewage treatment plant.

Public Toilets

We have had five separate incidents of vandalism at the toilets. We have reduced the daily opening times and closed them at weekends. The external area CCTV has been checked and has been reported to the police.
